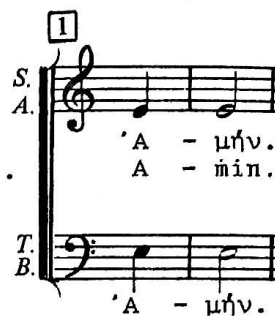

A - ΕΣΠΕΡΙΝΟΣ - AT VESPERS

If ARTOKLASIA is observed at Vespers, begin here.

ΙΕΡΕΥΣ: (Priest). Εἴη τὸ κράτος τῆς βασιλείας σου
 εὐλογημένον, καὶ δεδοξασμένον, τοῦ Πατρὸς
 καὶ τοῦ Υἱοῦ, καὶ τοῦ Ἁγίου Πνεύματος, νῦν
 καὶ ἀεὶ, καὶ εἰς τοὺς αἰῶνας τῶν αἰώνων:

Special Sticheron or Apolytikion when there is a procession from
 the North Side of the Bema. IEP: Σῶσον ὁ Θεὸς τὸν λαόν σου. . .
 καὶ ἐλέησον ἡμᾶς. Choir responds with three-fold Κύριε, see No.
 2 below.



B - ΕΙΣ ΤΗΝ ΛΕΙΤΟΥΡΓΙΑΝ -
 AT THE LITURGY

If ARTOKALASIA is observed at the close of Liturgy, it may begin with
 the following Litany. Note that the order and number of responses may
 vary with various celebrations of this service.

[2] Litany with three-fold Kyrie. ΙΕΡΕΥΣ: Ἐλέησον ἡμᾶς ... καὶ ἐλέησον:

Κύ-ρι' ἐ - λέ - η - σον, Ky-ri' e - le - i - son, Ky-ri' e - le - i - son.

ΙΕΡΕΥΣ: Ἐτι δεόμεθα ὑπὲρ τῶν εὐσεβῶν καὶ ὀρθοδόξων Χριστιανῶν:

[3] MEN

Κύ-ρι' ἐ - λέ - η - σον, Ky-ri' e - le - i - son, Ky-ri' e - le - i - son.

ΙΕΡΕΥΣ: Ἐτι δεόμεθα ὑπὲρ τοῦ Ἀρχιεπισκόπου ἡμῶν (δεῦνος) καὶ πάσης τῆς
 ἐν Χριστῷ ἡμῶν ἀδελωότητος:
